

Comprehension is the goal of reading. These strategies help students actively construct meaning before, during, and after reading.

Weekly Look-Fors

- ☐ Predict-read-confirm at key stopping points
- ☐ Reciprocal teaching roles: predict, question, clarify, summarize
- ☐ Visualizing and sketching to reveal understanding gaps
- ☐ Text-based questions from literal to inferential
- ☐ Three-minute turn-and-talk after every reading block
- ☐ Quick check: can the student summarize with evidence?

Quick Tip

Comprehension improves when students discuss the text. A 3-minute turn-and-talk beats a silent worksheet.
